




The Musical of Musicals

In this hilarious satire of musical theatre, one story becomes five delightful mini-musicals, each written in the distinctive style of a different master of the form. **The Basic Plot:** June is an ingenue who can't pay the rent and is threatened by her evil landlord. Will the handsome leading man come to the rescue? The variations are: a Rodgers & Hammerstein version, set in Kansas in August, complete with a dream ballet; a Sondheim version, featuring the landlord as a tortured artistic genius who slashes the throats of his tenants in revenge for not appreciating his work; a Jerry Herman version, as a splashy star vehicle; an Andrew Lloyd Webber version, a rock musical with themes borrowed from Puccini; and a Kander & Ebb version, set in a speakeasy in Chicago.



The Man Who Came to Dinner

Staged in honor of Corrine Goodman's 93rd birthday! As a High School senior, Corrine played the leading lady in this perennially popular classic of American comedy. Hart and Kaufman based the play on the personality and behavior of real life theatre critic and raconteur Alexander Wolcott, who was infamous for his huge ego, curmudgeonly rudeness, and generally obnoxious behavior. **The Story:** Sheridan Whiteside, our star, is invited to dine at the house of rich factory owner Ernest W. Stanley and his family. However, before Whiteside enters the house, he slips on a patch of ice outside the front door and injures his hip. Confined to the house for a month, "Sherry" drives his hosts mad by viciously insulting them, monopolizing their house and staff, running up large phone bills, and receiving many bizarre guests, including paroled convicts. The delightfully tangled plot delivers laughs galore with the final satisfaction of watching our irascible star get his well-deserved comeuppance.




A Piece of My Heart
